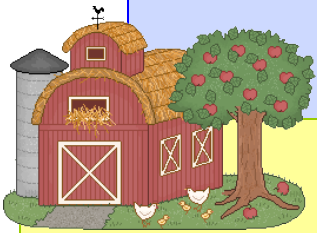




Explorer's October Newsletter
